Rotarian Foundation of Livermore Awards Community Grants Totaling \$81,500

On April 13, the Rotarian Foundation of Livermore (RFL) recognized its community grant recipients, awarding \$81,500 to twenty-two community organizations at the Rotary Club of Livermore Valley. More than 70 people attended the virtual meeting.

From 1999–2021, the Foundation has awarded over \$1,381,650 in community grants. Also, in 2021, a grant of over \$30,000 was given to the Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District for distance learning equipment needs during the pandemic.
